Church Council met last night to discuss the current state of our community and Cornerstone Community Church. After much discussion and thought the Council has decided that all non-church related functions at the facility will be canceled until further notice. This includes all AA meetings. Church related meetings will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines that have been provided to us by local and federal government agencies. As of right now, that means that all meetings will be limited in size to 10 or less participants. During these meetings every attempt will be made to provide what is being called "social distancing". We will avoid physical contact and try to meet in the largest rooms available.

The council has decided that Sundays the building will be open. We will hold services at our normal time and we will be streaming all services live online and recording them. For anyone who chooses to come to the church building on Sundays we are going to ask that these same "social distancing" practices be exercised. Please avoid physical touch as much as possible. Please respect other people's space and try to maintain 6 feet of separation from non-family members. The self-serve Coffee bar will be closed. If we have volunteers to operate the Café, it will be open.

We want to stress that attending service in the building is an option. There are many other options available too. We want our members and worshipers to make the choice that is best for their personal conditions. If you are in a vulnerable class, we recommend that you participate in one of the remote worship options. If you are sick, please stay home and worship from your home.

Please continue to pray for our community, our nation, and the world. As we all attempt to cope and deal with the reality that people are getting sick, we need to focus on the good news of Jesus Christ and know that he is bigger than all this that is surrounding us.
